

# Licensed Vocational Nursing

Licensed Vocational Nurses care for ill, injured, or convalescing patients or persons with disabilities in hospitals, nursing homes, clinics, private homes, group homes, and similar institutions. May work under the supervision of a registered nurse. An LVN must be certified and licensed to perform duties.

Employees in this field usually have an Associates Degree or some college level experience. The occupation prefers three to four years of related on-the-job experience. Individuals with strong attention to detail and social well being are essential working styles.
