

Secondary School Teachers

Secondary School Teachers, usually known as High School Teachers, educate teenagers ages 14-18 in grades 9, 10, 11 and 12. Some specialize in single subjects while others may teach two or more related subjects. Teachers prepare and assign lessons on approved criteria, develop and administer tests, grade papers and tests, and record students' progress. Teachers observe and evaluate students' performance and potential and give extra instruction when needed. They meet with parents and school staff to discuss a student's academic progress or personal problems.

Employees in this field must have a Bachelor's degree. Teachers are expected to have strong oral expression, speech clarity and data analysis. The teacher must identify measures or indicators of performance and develop plans to improve the performance.
