Who do I call if I am not sure which service I need? Please call 2-1-1, United Way's FREE helpline, for referrals to an

appropriate transportation provider.
2-1-1 operates 24 hours and 7 days a week, with bilingual service

What are the different types of transit service?

There are three basic types of transit service in the Brazos Valley:

- 1. **Fixed Route** (offered only in Bryan/College Station) this service operates a particular route on a fixed schedule. This service operates Mon Fri only, excluding holidays.
- 2. ADA Paratransit is a shared ride curb to curb service offered for those who cannot access the fixed routes due to a disability, and have an origin and destination within 3/4 of a mile of the Fixed Routes. For more information please visit the website at www.btd.org or call 1-800-272-0039.
- 3. **Demand-Response Service** this service is offered in all seven counties and offers curb-to-curb service anywhere you want to go. This service is available on Monday Friday, excluding holidays. There may be restrictions on what days service is offered in or between certain areas. For more information please visit the website at www.btd.org or call 1-800-272-0039.

I am a Medicaid recepient. Who do I call to set-up a ride to my appointment?

All Medicaid trips <u>must</u> be scheduled through Medicaid. The District cannot schedule your trip. Please call 866-905-8545 to schedule your trip through Medicaid.

Are the transportation resources listed accessible by wheelchair?

The "passenger type" column in the resource guide will show a wheelchair logo if the transportation provider has indicated their service has wheelchair accessible vehicles. Not all of the providers' vehicles may be equipped to handle wheelchairs. Please call ahead of your scheduled pick-up to request a wheelchair accessible vehicle.

I travel with a Personal Care Assistant (PCA). May my PCA travel free, or at a discount rate?

You should call the transportation provider at least 24 hours ahead of time to determine a rate for your PCA. Some providers offer free or discounted rates, while other providers charge the full fare.


