Biological Technicians assist biological and medical scientists in laboratories. Set up, operate, and maintain laboratory instruments and equipment, monitor experiments, make observations, and calculate and record results. The technician may analyze organic substances such as blood, food, and drugs.

Employees in this field usually have Bachelor Degrees and one or two years of training. The potential Biological Technician needs strong biology, chemistry, and mathematical skills. The employees in this occupation must have strong reading comprehension, critical thinking, and data analysis skills.
