Computer Support Specialist provide technical assistance to computer users. They answer questions or resolve computer problems for clients in person, or via telephone or electronically. They may provide assistance concerning the use of computer hardware and software, including printing, installation, word processing, electronic mail, and operating systems. Classroom training and on-the-job training are needed.

Employees in this field must have at least a high school diploma or GED and have completed some post secondary training. The occupation will appeal to those who enjoy set procedures, critical thinking, and analysis of hardware or data. Computer skills and knowledge of hardware or programs are required.
